## Mother Christine Retires as Abbess

On the 14<sup>th</sup> December 2021 M. Christine will celebrate her 75<sup>th</sup> birthday and according to our Constitutions she offers her, resignation which has been accepted and will come into effect on 15<sup>th</sup> December. M. Christine was elected on 14<sup>th</sup> February 2006 and then re-elected in 2012 for an indefinite time. So much has changed during her abbatial mandate: the new library, rebuilding the cloisters, redesign the cloister garden, upgrading the infirmary, new patio, and the reordering of the church. The grounds, two fields, which had been rented to a local farmer were bought back into use with the planting of mixed woodland, starting the market garden which now has 2 small greenhouses, 5 polytunnels and 33 allotment beds, developing the gardens, moving, and expanding the orchard. Changing from oil boilers for heating and hot water to a biomass boiler and solar panels. Organising and renewing our
